Sigmacom was one of eight companies from Ontario exhibiting at the International Cable and Satellite Television trade show, Birmingham, England, in September, at a stand sponsored and organized by the Ontario Ministry of Industry and Trade, Toronto.

Local company in bidding

BIRMINGHAM, ENGLAND - A determined bid to establish a presence in a new UK industry that is expected to boom during the next few years was made by eight Ontario companies exhibiting among 150 others at the International Cable and Satellite Television

(CAST) trade show which closed here after a four-day run in September.

Among the exhibitors was Mike Taylor, president of Sigmacom Systems in Whitby.

Taylor said Sigmacom was considering setting up their own UK office to handle sales of complete satellite receiving station for either cable companies or home users.

Apart from the actual cable, the Ontario exhibitors showed most of everything needed by a cable company starting from scratch: dish antennae, connectors, amplifiers, receivers, modulators and demodulators, switching and microwave equipment, as well as cleaners and profilers for broadcast and production tapes, a satellite earth receiving station, cable engineering products and even a specialised computer software package for cable station administration. Descriptions like, "worthwhile, extremely valuable", "excellent exposure", fell readily from the lips of Ontario company representatives attending the exhibition. However, most admitted that cash sales would come later when the British government finally names the 12 licensees it will allow to establish cable systems in the UK mainland.
