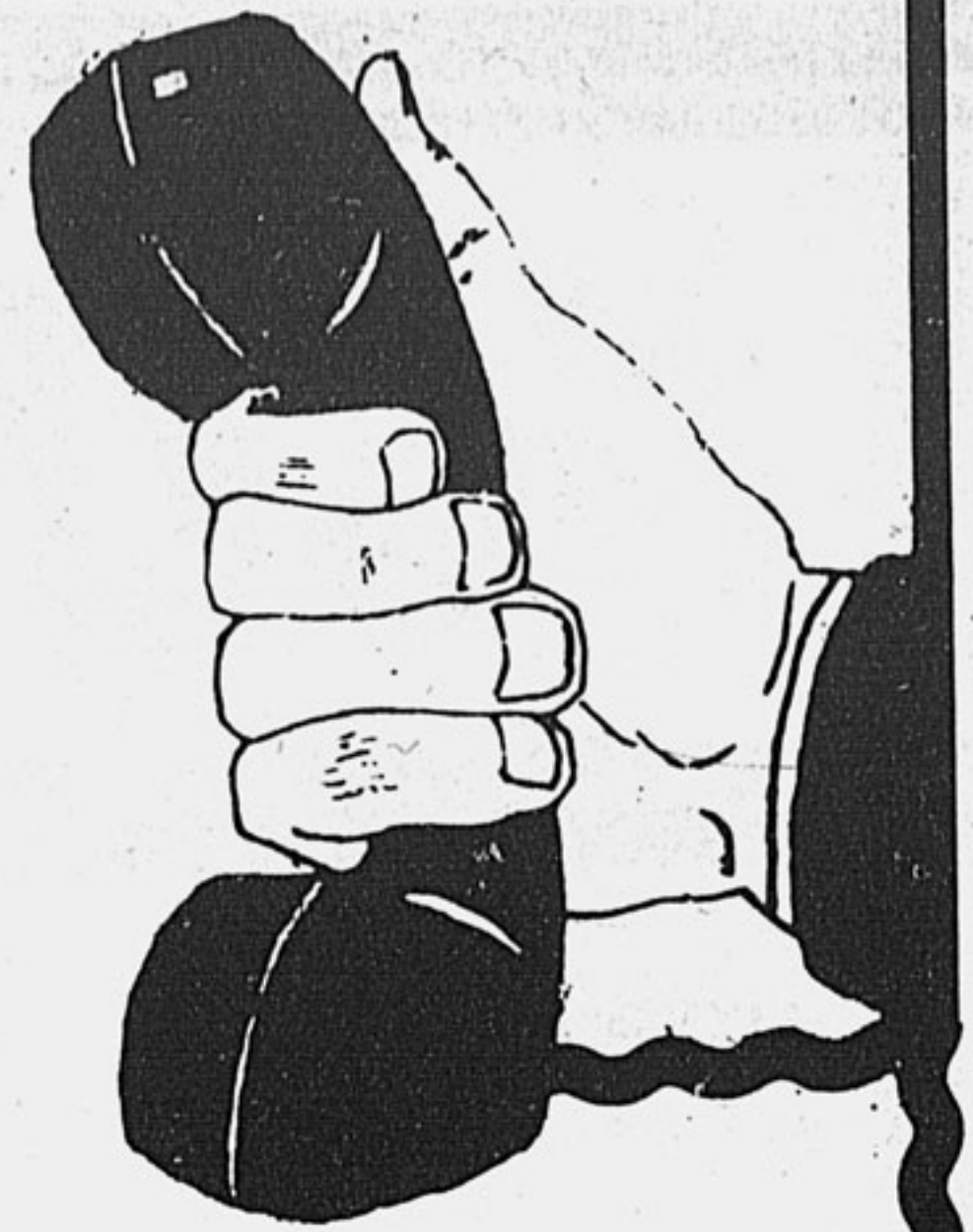

High school students advance in badminton play

Anderson players Roxanne Kwan and Laura Oepfen each placed third in their respective senior and junior divisions. The team of Jennifer Roy and Laura Bird, also from Anderson, captured fourth place in the junior girls' doubles division.

"All the players played well," says Anderson coach Andrew Uranowski. "The competition was excellent, and we're very pleased."

From Henry St., Heather Van Patter managed a first-place finish in the senior girls' single division,

and the junior boys' doubles team of Royston McMahon and Bob McCutcheon places third.

Henry St. coach Silvia Grdovic was similarly pleased with her team's placement, and says she

was 'not surprised' with Van Patter's win.

"Everybody's pleased. We didn't

have any placements last year at LOSSA, and we've come a long way since then."

Farewell was fifth in the team standings, with the championship going to Central Park.

Two students from Dr. Robert Thornton Public School in Whitby has fourth-place finishes. Mike Baker ranked fourth in the 72-kg. division and Colin Vale was fourth in the 54-kg. class.
