Black bear sighted at Lyndebrook Golf Course

BROOKLIN -- A black bear was seen wandering around Lyndebrook Golf Course, located north of Garden Street and Robert Atterslev Drive in Brooklin, on May 11.

Durham police responded to a call about the sighting at about 8:30 p.m. Sergeant Bill Calder said the bear posed no threat to residents and left the area shortly after officers arrived.

"They will tend to keep to themselves ... if anyone else spots them, we'll definitely attend just to keep assessing," he said the following morning.

Sgt. Calder added that bear sightings are not uncommon near forested areas across Durham. "Officers will go out, we'll check the area, ensure that it's safe."
