It was then that Mayor Bill McLean disclosed that Eric would also have a steet dedicated to him, Smith Lane. Unfortunately, Eric was unable to see his street. He had planned to visit in 1999 for the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration, but died unexpectedly that August.

His sons, Ken and Ray were able to attend the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in Ajax to honour their father and officially dedicate Smith Lane to his memory.
