Solomon Chatterson, Esq., farmer, Mohawk, was born in the County of Wentworth, Oct. 87.1824, and is a son of Joseph and Sophia (Kerlin) Chatterson. His father was born in Canada and his mother in England; the former was a pensioner of the War of 1812. The subject of this sketch was twice married. His first wife was Eliza Ann. daughter of Robert McAlister, and was the mother of three children, viz.: Almanza, born Feb. 5. 1850; Alceona, born May 11. 1851, died Warch, 1872; Arrinthes, born Sept. 30, 1852. He married again Nov. 1, 1871. Sarah Calista Terhune, daughter of Carret and Olive J. (Dresser) Terhune. She was born June 29, 1846, and also has four children as follows: Leslie W. born July 14, 1872; Alice R. born Sept. 28, 1873; Romma R. Born June 18, 1875; Rfrie O., born Oct. 19, 1881, Mr. Chatterson. who came to this county in 1845 . owns 395 acres of superior farming land on Mount Pleasant Street, has for a number of years held a commission of Justice of the Peace, and is a member of the Methodist Church. In his youth he received a common school education . and his career through life has been one of probity and honour. Robert A. Chatterson-

Robert A. Chatterson, farmer, Brantford Township, was born in Ancaster, Township, County of Wontworth, March 9, 1820, and came to Brant County in 1839. His father, Joseph, was born in New Jersey, and came to Camada with his father, Elias. Joseph married Sophia, daughter of John Kerlin, of Knglish descent. The said John Kerlin was an officer in the Revolutionary War, on the English side. His wife, Sussanah Buras, was related to Robert Burns. Robert A. Chatterson was one of thirteen children, two of whom died in infancy, the remaining being John Burns, Eschiel, Kliss, Robert A., Susannah, Solomon, Charlotte, Henry, Albert, Willam, and Elias J.

Robert merried, Nov. 23, 1641. Elmire, daughter of John W. & Laura Cook, natives of Duchess County, New York. They are the parents of three children, vis., Emily L., born April4th, 1845, married Israel T. Dawson, Aug. 27, 1867; Mary L., born July 11, 1849, married Chas. D. Smith, Sept. 6th, 1876; Joseph M., born Sept. 25, 1855, now practising law in Louisvelle, Kentucky. Mr. Chatterson is now owner of ninety acres of fine farming land in Brantford Township. He is a Justice of the Peace, holds a first-class certificate, and has taught school a period of twenty years in the Counties of Brant and Oxford. He is now enjoying the fruits of his labour.

David Burtch, farmer, Brantford Township, a native of this county, was born Nov. 23, 1815, and is a son of Stephen and grandson of David Burtch, a native of England, who went to the American Colonies about the middle of the last century, and died at Albany, in what subsequently became the State of New York. Stephen Burtch, his sire. was born at Balltown, New York State, in 1767, and came to Canada in 1796, locating near Niagara until 1893, when he removed to Brant County. About the year 1807 he married Margaret Belanger, daughter of Jacob Belanger, a native of Germany, their union being blessed with nine children, viz., Lucy and William (deceased) CHETIGIES, Manan Xanax Zanax Esther, David, Adelia, Ann. Mary (deceased) Charlotte, Susan and Jane. After battling with the forests of Brant County for twenty years, this brave old pioneermx was gathered to his fathers in 1833, at the age of 66, leaving behind him a record of good deeds for emulation by his prosperity. David Burtch, the subject of our biography was married twice. His first wife was Anna Smith, daughter of Amos Smith, a native of New York State, to whom he was married June 20, 1835. The result of their marriage was six children, as follows; Daniel, born Nov. 6, 1836; Jane, born Sept. Txx 17, 1838;

died, Mey 24, 1867; Stephen, born Nov. 6, 1840; Devid, born Jan. 15, 1842; Silas, born July 16, 1844, died Oct. 6, 1845; Honickel, born IMERCES, Nov. 23, 1847. His wife dying June 1, 1856, he married again June 12, 1861, Nancy Ann Clarko, who is still living. Mr. Burtch is in confortable circumstances, being the owner of a splendid furm of 172 acres, upon which he has resided since his birth, and 92 acres of excellent land in the Village of Mount Fleesant, all of which is well stocked and under a superior state of cultivation. He has held the office of Justice of the Peace for the past few years having received his appointment from the Dominion Government. He is a member of the Esptist church. David Burtch, Jr., his son, married Lucretia Clark, daughter of Villiam and Susan (Huffman) Clark, of Clanford. He resides on the farm with his father.

William Houlding-

William Houlding, Farmer, Newbort, was born Oct. 9, 1816, and is a son of Thomas, grandson of Thomas and great-grandson of William Houlding. a native of Lancashire. England, who died in the lang of his birth. The grandfather of our subject came to Canada in 1831, and settled in Brant County. He married Ann Draper, also a native of England, and had seven children, Thomas, Ann, Betty and William, who are living, and Jane and Henry, now dead. William Houlding, of whom this sketch is written , came to Canada from England in 1831, and married July 1, 1848, Betty Birkett, daughter of William Birkett, of English descent. The children of this marriage number fourteen, as follows: Thomas, born May 5. 1842; William, born May 29. 1843; Ann. born June 14. 1845; Ellen. born JEMEXICXXISCSX Aug. 16. 1847: James. born May 15. 1849: Mary J., born March 15, IMAXX 1851; Henry A., born Dec. 31, 1853; died June 24, 1865; Rachel & Rebecca, born April 8, 1855 (Rebecca died April 10, 1875, and Rachel July 25, 1876); Isadora, born Mar. 15, 1857; George, born Feb. 23, 1859; Charles D., born Feb. 24, 1861;

John A., born July 27, 1865; Hertha E., born Merch 31, 1867. Mr. Houlding owns a splendid farmof 160 acres on the Grahd River, four miles below the City of Brantford, and is a prosperous farmer. He and his family belong to the Independent Church.

Garrett Terhune-

Garrett Terhune, farmer, Brantford P.O., was born April 13, 1823, in New Jersey, and is the son of Gilliam and Mary (Roome) Terhune, and a grandson of Albert and Mary (VanRinner) Terbune. Mr. Terbune came to Canada with his parents in 1836, and settled in Norfolk County with his grandfather. Albert Terhune. His father was born Nov. 4. 1790. and married Jan. 9. 1813. Mary Roome, who was born March 25. 1792. They were the parents of seven children, named, Ann, born Mar. 28, 1814. Albert, born Mar. 30, 1816; Samuel, born Sept. 9, 1819; died Mar. 24, 1873; John. born Jan. 18, 1826, died August 29, 1848; Peter, born Mar. 4, 1829; and Abraham, born Oct. 15, 1831, died Feb. 21, 1849, Garrett Terhume was married twice, his first wife being Olive Josephine, daughter of Frederick Dresser, of American descent: she died April 11, 1859. leaving six children, named Sarah C., Mary J., Susan C., Agnes S., Harriet A/. (dead) and Emms L. He married again Aug. 29, 1860, Angeline A., daughter of Timothy Fairchild, who was born Nov. 30, 1835, by whom he had three children- Frederick L.. Lucy C., and John F. Mr. Terhune holds the position of Justice of the Peace, and is an Rider in Zion Church, Brantford.

THE CHATTERSON's.

The Chatterson's were one of the pioneer families of Mount Fleesant Methodist Church, the forerunger of the Mount Fleesant United Church. This brief history is from information provided by Mrs. Hugh MacLechlan, Mrs. Cecil Longstreet and from the History of Frant Oonsty, 1833. Mrs. MacLechlan also supplied the photograph.

...

Solomon Chatterson was born in Weatworth County, October 27, 1824. We are told that part of the present Brant County was at that time Gore District of Weatworth County. His father was Joseph, who was born in dew Jersey, U.S.A. and was a pensioner from the war of 1812-1814; his aother was Sophia Kerlin. Solomon married Blize Ann, daughter of Kobert McAlister, ancestor of the McAlister family of this church and community. Two of the children of Solomon and Blize died young, the remaining three surviving to found femiliee, some of whose descendants are resident here.

The first of these was Almanzar, born February 5, 1850; he married Sarah Nott; their daughter, Florence, married Thomas Longstreet and this couple were the parents of Gordon, Helen, Lloyd and Cecil. Cecil and Mildred Longstreet live in this community. We notice with this generation the sudden change away from the old Biblical names. The cross on the communion table of our church was donated to the Mount Pleasant United Church in 1953 by Cecil's mother and dedicated to the memory of her parents.

Next was Alceona, born May 11, 1851, who became Mrs. Hardy; the Hardy's had one daughter. Alceona died in March of 1872.

The last was Arrinthia, born September 30, 1852, who married Harry Fryer. Their children were Dr. James Fryer, an agricultural specialist, Alice, known as Allie, a teacher, Florence and Audrey. The last two daughters of

the Fryer's are well-recemberd for their years of dedicated work in our church. Audrey, as Mrs. Ed Cleveland, had two sons, Harry and Jack and a daughter, Helen. Helen died as a young girl. Jack still lives on Pleasant Ridge Road near his old home.

Solomon's wife, Blize, died in 1852 but he did not re-manry until November 1, 1871, after his children were married and settled on neighbouring farms of their own. His second wife was Sarah Calisto Terhune who was born in 1846; they had six children.

Leslie H. was born July 14, 1972; he married Hellie Hustington and practised law in Chicago. Alice E. was born September 28, 1873, taught public school in this area and married Herbert Henner. Emms R., born July 18, 1875 became Mrs. William Burtch and the sother of Mobel (Mrs. Fraser) and Mildred (Mrs. Hugh McClachlan), the latter of this church. Effic Olive, born October 19, 1931, married the Rev. Welter Davidson, a clergyman-emigrá from Scotland. Lottie Kerlin was born in 1894 and married Charles Kew. The Kew residence was on the NGGill Tract prior to their moving to Galifornia. Sloon Arnold Ghatterson, born in 1986, was of rather frail health and died in 1911, the year after the death of his father, Solomon. Sarah, the mother, lived until 1917.

There being no training facilities here for nurses Effice went to Chicago, circa 1903, to train as a Registeered Murse and was followed soon in that profession by her younger sister, Lottie. They resolved to purchase from their first pey following graduation, a communion service for the Mount Pleasant Methodiat Church, se the use of the common chalie they felt to be unsanitary. The service they donated is on display in the glass case in the marthex of the church, along with the one replaced by their gift.

While nursing in Chicago, Effie encountered the Nev. Walter Davidson, the abovementioned minister, who was interested in becoming involved in social work on this continent. At their first weeting she was in the midst of bathing a little black baby and it embarrassed her to have a stranger watching her. But she allowed him to take her to digner and they struck up a correspondence after the reverend gentleman returned to his home in Edmonton. Alberta. She later accepted his invitation to travel to Edmonton. Her friends asked with sensible caution. "How do you know he'll be there to meet you?" Her reply was a confident. "I know he'll be there!" and off she went by train from Chicago to Edmonton. In due course they were married there, where a son was born and later, two daughters. Mr. Davidson became the Manager of the Eastern Region of the American Red Cross, residing in Washington, D. C. for some years.

Solomon Chatterson was concerned for the moral and religious upbringing of the youth of the day and conducted a Sanday School for many years in the Plessont Ridge Public School. Mrs. MacLachian recalls that a picture of her grandfather hung in the school for some time after his passing. An amusing anecdote about his goes to the effect that he felt there should be apuse for a choir behind the pulpit area of our church; hence, the bricked addition on the west end of the building and which momenom called 'Solomon's Santle', which, when seen from outside, alluded to the shape of the lady's dress style of that mass.






