# GRAND RIVER HERITAGE MINES SOCIETY ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2002

Mission/Goals: Our society locates, records, and preserves history and artifacts of the gypsum mining and milling industry mainly in the Grand River Watershed. We also gather information about the people involved, and how the gypsum industry affects their communities. We study the plant and animal life and the geology associated with the mine sites. We study the historic marl and iron industries as well. Part of our mandate is to publish and disseminate information, by providing field trips, walking tours, displays, and by public speaking and providing a newsletter and other publications.
