Assignment to Canada and the Change in Task

Commodore Owen boarded HMS *Niobe* on 17 December 1814 for the trip across the Atlantic to Halifax. Midshipman Alexander Thomas Emeric Vidal joined him as secretary.⁸ They travelled with Major General Sir George Murray,
