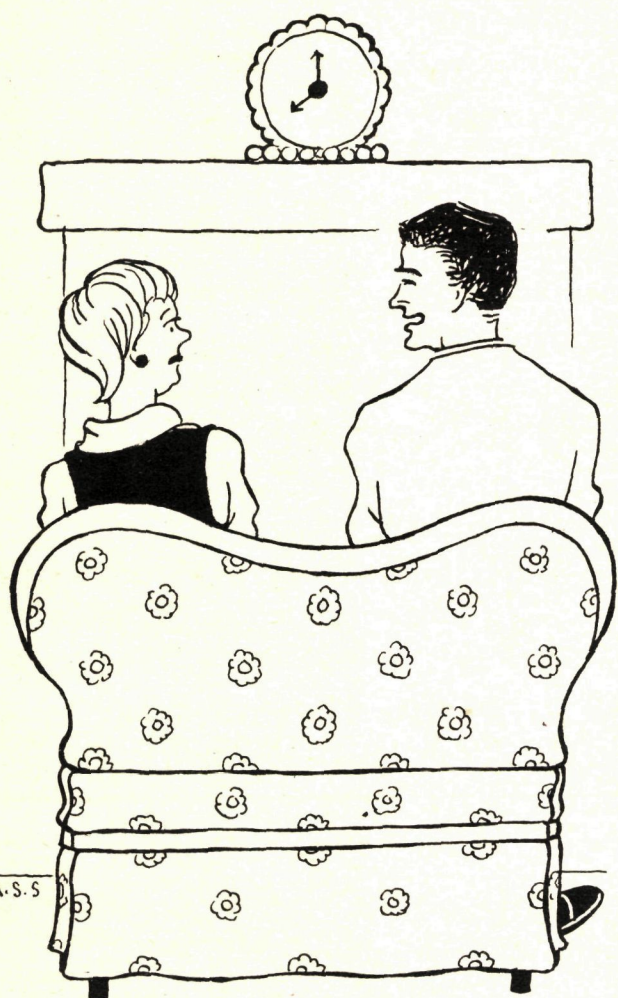


Role of Parents, Teachers Will Be Probed

What is the parent's role in the teaching of values?

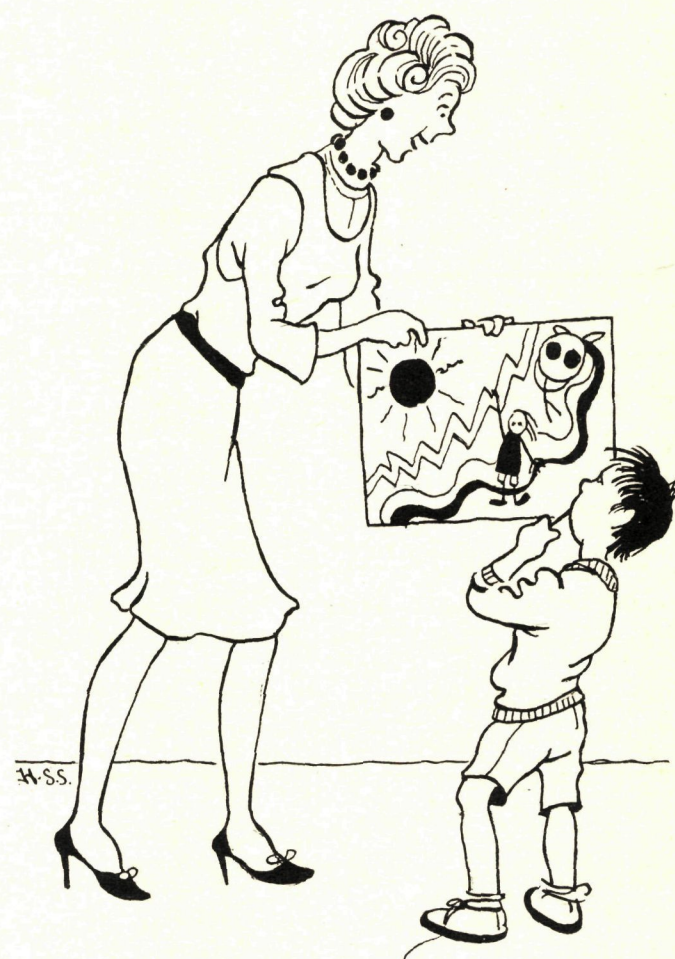
The role of parents and teachers in a child's development will be the subject of the North Shore Mental Health Association's fall seminar Nov. 3 in Winnetka Community House.

The featured speaker at the event, to be held from 10:15 to 2:30 p.m. in Winnetka Community House, will be Dr. Rudolf Ekstein, a member of the staff of the Reiss-Davis Clinic in Los Angeles and director of its project on child psychosis. He will discuss "Parents and Teachers—Who Does What?"

Glencoe artist Helena Seaberg has sketched for this page illustrations of some of the topics Dr. Ekstein and the seminar participants will discuss.



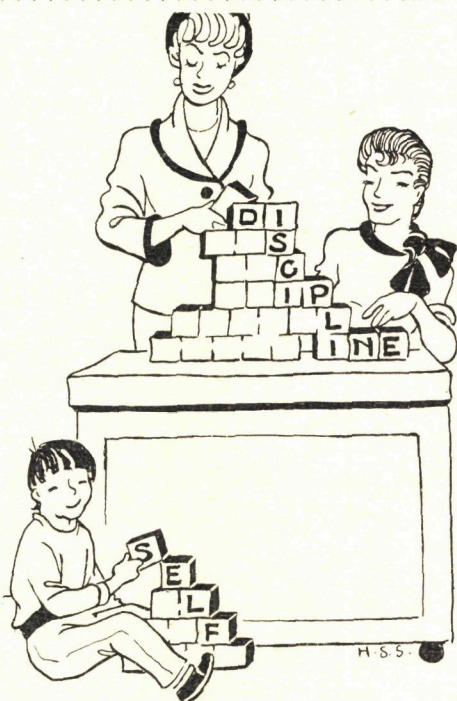

Should teachers be therapists?



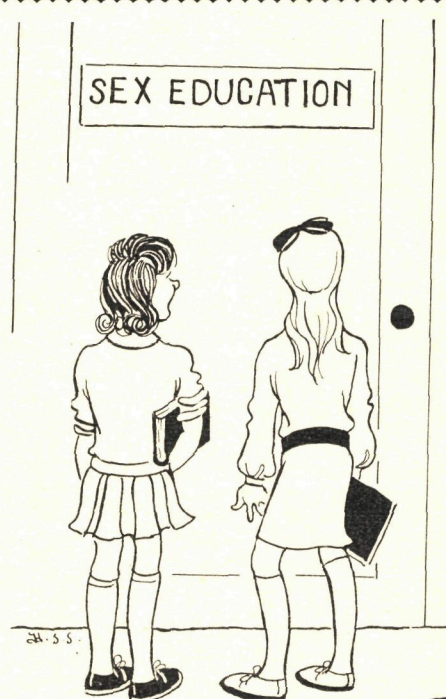
For Pete's sake! She's only one year old! Can't you wait and let the school do the job?
