

## IREDALES BUY MORE 'HOUSES'

**Warehouse People Take  
Highland Park Business**

The Iredale Warehouse company of Evanston and Wilmette has purchased the Highland Park Fireproof Storage company and the Highland Park Transfer company, Earl C. Iredale, president, announced this week. The consideration was \$100,000.

Both concerns will bear the name of the Highland Park Transfer and Storage company. The buildings purchased will be used until a modern brick and terra cotta structure is erected two years hence to replace both.

The Highland fireproof building is located on a site 40 by 200 feet, with a floor space of 25,000 square feet. The deal provided for the transfer of the full equipment of vans and trucks.

Alexander Rafferty, former part owner and manager of the Highland Park Transfer company, has been placed in charge of the new concern. He will work under the stockholders of the Evanston company: Mr. Iredale, president; G. B. Anderson, secretary-treasurer; Mrs. Walter H. Iredale, and Mrs. Anderson and Mrs. H. M. Prior, sisters of Mr. Iredale.

D. C. Purdy and Son were owners of the Highland Park Transfer company building purchased by the Evanston company. They operated a hardware store in connection with the storage plant. Until a new building which is under way is completed, Purdy & Son will continue to reserve a portion of the building for their store. Their new building will be completed about August 1, when the Highland Park Transfer & Storage company will take full possession of the building.

The Iredale Warehouse company has its main office in Evanston, and a branch company in Winnetka. With the establishment of two more branches in Highland Park, it will serve residents as far north as Lake Forest.

George S. Kingsley has drawn plans for the new building. Three stories will rise on a site 50 by 150 feet, but will be built for a five story height. This building will not be started however, for at least two years, Mr. Iredale said. In the meantime, the two buildings just purchased will be used for the more distant towns on the north shore.

### NEW SNOW REMOVER

## REPLACE TENTS WITH HOUSES AT REST CAMP

Tents used at the Arden Shore Rest camp for the summer visitors from the Chicago tenement districts are to be replaced by permanent houses, if present plans of the board of directors of the camp materialize.

The camp, which is considered the north shore's own charity venture, has been satisfied with tents to date, but finds that building costs warrant erection of permanent buildings.

Workers in the cause of the contemplated improvement have sent out the accompanying information:

"Tents wear out—and at Arden Shore this year five tents, in which the summer visitors live, must be discarded. Owing to increased cost of tent material and the labor of putting up and taking down each year a permanent house can now be built for a sum very little larger than the present cost of a tent.

"To replace the tents with houses is the place of the board of directors. One house has been given as a memorial and various organizations along the north shore are working to supply the others, exclusive of funds from the yearly drive.

"In Wilmette the board members and their friends are to play cards at a benefit party, the proceeds to go toward a new house at the camp."
