

New Addition to Auto Row

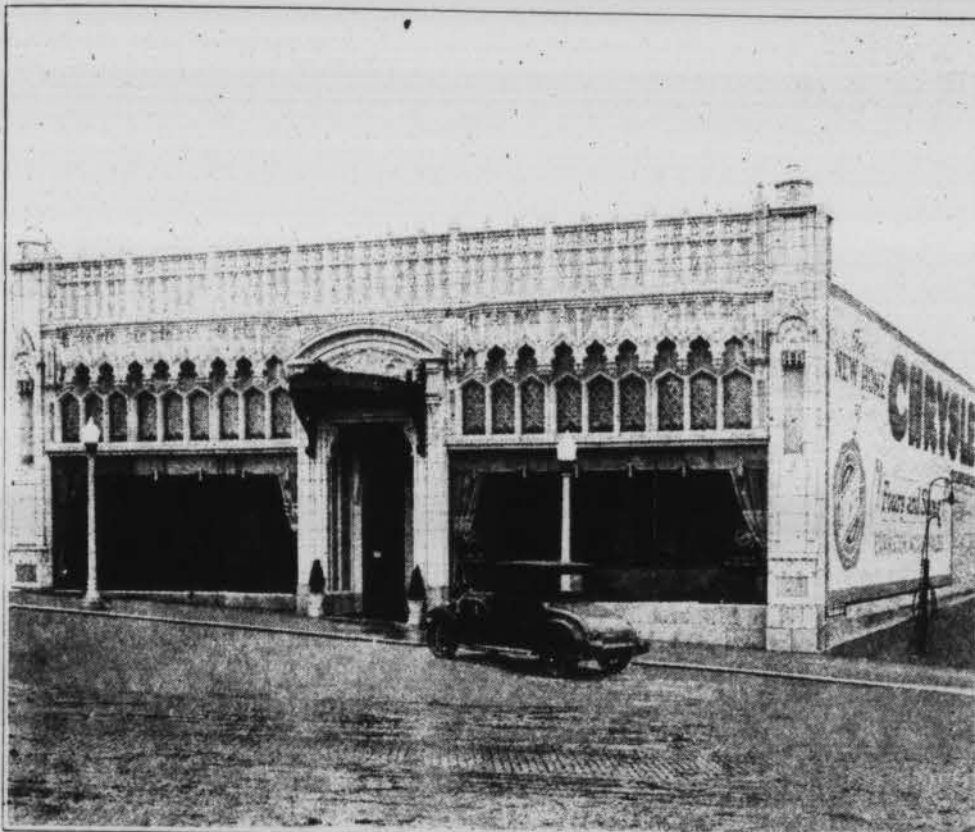
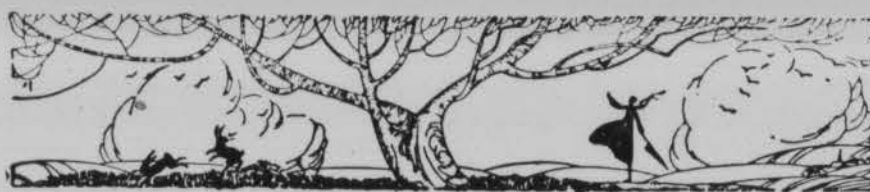
