Special Assessment Notice

Notice is hereby given to all persons
interested that the Village of Kenilworth,
Cook County, Illinois, having ordered that
a local improvement consisting of a con-
nected system of vitrified, salt glazed, hub
and spigot tile pipe sanitary sewers be
constructed as follows:

Beginning at and connecting to the
present sanitary sewer at the intersec-
tion of the south line of West Kenilworth
Avenue and a line five (5) feet west of
and parallel with the west line of the
Kenilworth Community Development Sub-
division; thence southerly in an easement,
nine hundred ninety (990) feet to a
point twelve (12) feet west of the west
line of said Kenilworth Community Devel-
opment Subdivision, including brick ma-
sonry manholes, vitrified tile slants or
Y's for house connections, closed with tile
discs, connection to existing sewer, drop
connections for manholes, vitrified salt
glazed tile pipe, pipe laying, sheeting,
trenching, grubbing, backfilling, restora-
tion of sidewalks where disturbed, and
removal of all surplus materials, all with-
in the Village of Kenilworth, County of
Cook and State of Illinois, the ordinance
for the same being on file in the office of
the Village Clerk of said village, and the
said village having applied to the County
Court of Cook County, Illinois, for an
assessment of the cost of said improve-
ment according to the benefits, and a
special assessment therefor having been
made and returned to said Court, Docket
Number 21, the final hearing thereon will
be held on the tenth day of January, A.
D. 1927, or as soon thereafter as the busi-
ness of the said Court will permit. All
persons desiring may file objections in
said Court before said day, and may ap-
pear on the hearing and make their de-
fense. Said ordinance provides for the
collection of said assessment in five (5)
annual installments with interest thereon
at the rate of six per centum (6%) per
annum.
