

Road Tips

Illinois—42-A—Detour at Glenview; follow marked detour route west to Shermer road, then north into Northbrook, then easterly to Lee road, then northerly to Deerfield road, then west into Deerfield to Illinois-42-A (Waukegan road).

Irving Park boulevard is now open to traffic between Mannheim road and the county line; however, this road is closed between Cumberland avenue and Mannheim road. Traffic should be detoured south on Cumberland avenue to Forest Preserve road; southwest to River road; north to Bryn Mawr avenue; west to Mannheim road; and south to Irving Park boulevard.

Chicago to Lake Geneva, Wis.—Via Illinois-19 to Illinois-60; Illinois-60 to Illinois-20; Illinois-20 to McHenry; Illinois-61 to the Illinois-Wisconsin state line; US-12 to Lake Geneva, 73.6 miles. The last stretch of new pavement was opened on this route on August 12. This route is now all paved.

The people of Missouri will vote on a \$75,000,000 state highway bond issue this fall. The matter will be put before the voters through an initiative petition. Missouri authorized a \$60,000,000 highway bond issue not long ago.
