School Children Warned About "Dangerous Hour"

The dangerous hour between 4 and 5 p. m. is stressed in the Chicago Motor club safety poster for this month, and which was just placed in the school rooms. The accident prevention department of the club pointed out that more children are injured in that period than any other in the entire day. The reason is that the children are free from school and the protection of the School Boys' Patrol, and unless the teachers' safety lessons have been impressed upon them, are prone to become careless on the streets. Hundreds of young lives could be saved, it is believed, if this hour were made safer.

The poster depicts a clock, with the hour in question shaded, and the caption, "The Danger Hour." Underneath is the warning, "Careful Always—Extra Careful From 4 to 5." The teachers lead discussions in the various classes on the lesson portrayed in the posters.

Production, Sales of Graham-Paige in October Record

New production and shipping records for October were set by the Graham-Paige Motors corporation, raising the total output for ten months of 1928 to 70,406 cars, as compared with 18,800 for the same period of 1927, or a gain of 274 percent, according to Carl Hanson, of Hanson Motors, Winnetka dealer.

Production last month was 52 percent more than the best previous record for October, established in 1926, and was 3.6 times the total for October of last year.

For ten months of 1928, under the Graham management, the factory has averaged 7040 cars monthly production, higher by 1200 cars than the total for the best single month of the predecessor company.

Graham-Paige is to celebrate a big day on Nov. 20 when the \$1,500,000 Graham-Paige Body corporation plant is opened at Evansville, Ind. Civic appreciation of the big industry will be represented by banquets, a parade and a free public dance. All factories will be closed for the day.
