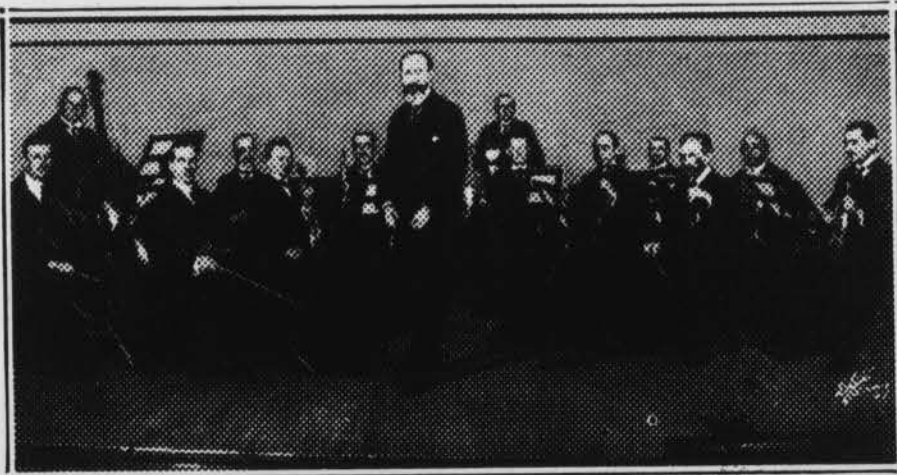


Barrere Symphony Here Sunday



SUNDAY afternoon, April 14, will witness the closing of the season for the North Shore Chamber Music association. The program, by George Barrere and his Little Symphony orchestra, promises a brilliant climax to an eminently successful year of concerts.

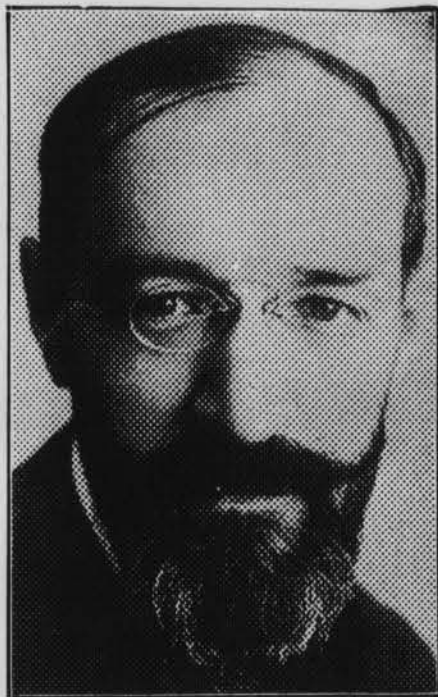
This concert, marking the first appearance of M. Barrere in this vicinity, is hailed as an unprecedented achievement for the Chamber Music association in that critics the world over have acclaimed the art of this group as perfect.

George Barrere came to this country from his native France twenty-three years ago and was an instant sensation. He is universally acclaimed as the world's greatest flautist, and has during the years assembled about him a group of musicians unexcelled in their chosen art.
