Describes London Government

The Lord Mayor of London, explained Mr. Binnie, is appointed and not elected. His advisors are members of the London County council. The city of London is a county divided into small boroughs. Each year the city plans a budget, and the duty of collecting for the expenses is given to the borough councils, who have to collect and pay the money in twice a year. London has a population of nearly eight millions, stated Mr. Binnie, and the city has not yet ceased to grow.



Every member of the New Trier team scored at least three points, and Bob Reschke, forward, made three field goals and four free throws for a total of ten points. Tom Hicks and Carleton Schroeder, guards, also played stellar games.
