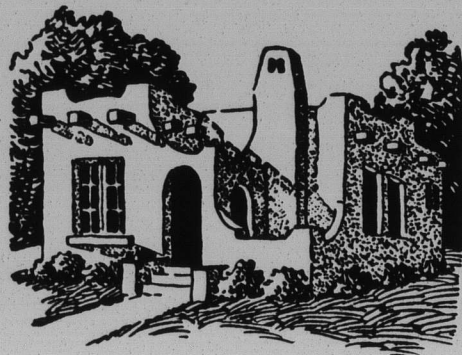


NEW PLAY PRESENTED

North Shore Line Offers Excursion Service June 1

Suburban communities north of Chicago along the lake shore to Great Lakes will be furnished Sunday excursion service to Kenosha, Racine and Milwaukee by the North Shore Line, beginning next Sunday, June 1, it was announced today by R. S. Amis, General Passenger Agent.

Special reduced rates for the round trip have been placed in effect for this new service. Persons taking advantage of these facilities will journey over the Shore Line route north to North Chicago Junction, where direct connections will be made with the northbound Chicago-Milwaukee excursion special operating each Sunday over the Skokie Valley route.

The points on the Shore Line route served by the excursion and the times of departure are: Church street, Evanston, 7:37 a. m. (Standard Time); Central street, Evanston, 7:41 a. m.; Linden avenue, Wilmette, 7:42 a. m.; Wilmette avenue, 7:46 a. m.; Kenilworth, 7:49 a. m.; Indian Hill, 7:52 a. m.; Winnetka, 7:54 a. m.; Hubbard Woods, 7:57 a. m.; Glencoe, 8:01 a. m.; Ravinia, 8:05 a. m.; Highland Park, 8:09 a. m.

On the return trip passengers living in Shore Line communities will board the Milwaukee-Chicago excursion special leaving Milwaukee terminal at 7:15 p. m., (Standard Time), Racine at 7:49 p. m., and Kenosha at 8 p. m., making direct connections with a Shore Line train at North Chicago Junction.
