



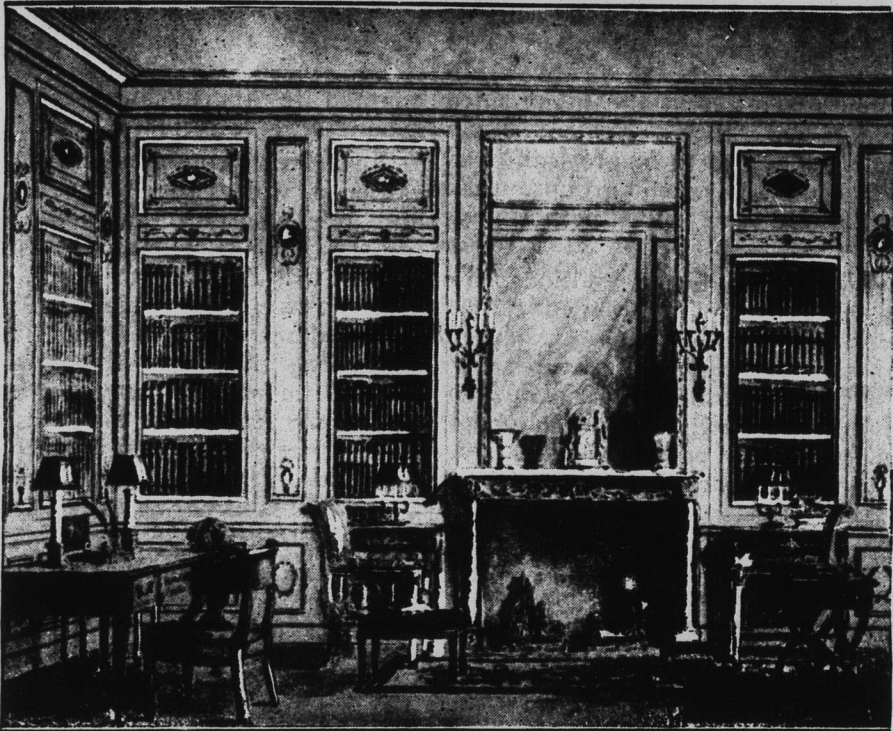

A Remarkably Fine Pair of Queen Anne Walnut Marquetry Chairs.

The cabriole legs show the characteristic shell carvings, and the graceful stretchers together with the unusual gargoyle in marquetry on the fiddle shaped back, definitely date them as belonging to the early part of the Queen Anne period.
