The Playground and Recreation board will retain its same officers for the 1931-32 season, according to a vote taken at the annual meeting last Thursday evening at the Recreation office.


Henry C. Fowler will serve the body as chairman for another year, and Director of recreation, Daniel M. Davis, will serve as secretary.
