Announce Winners in Annual School Field, Track Meet

Because of the previous Sunday's downpour of rain, the nineteenth annual Field Day events had to be postponed from the announced date, Tuesday, June 7, and was held on the following day when the sun had dried the grounds at the Vattman Park and the Village Green, where the activities were conducted.

An estimated crowd of 1,000 people witnessed the physical training demonstration, in which all the school children in the Wilmette public schools participated, in the morning at Vattman Park and an equal number was present at the Village Green when the annual track and field meet for the grammar schoool athletes was held.

The morning program, which was arranged by the director of the school physical education program Daniel M. Davis, and his staff, demonstrated the various phases of physical activity conducted in the regular gymnasium classes throughout the year. The lower grades demonstrated folk dances and rhythm plays, while the upper grades demonstrated corrective exercises, low organized games, relays, formal gymnastics, marching formations, and postural drills.

Athletes Compete

The afternoon's track meet was held for the athletes who had qualified for the final races in elimination contests conducted in the variclasses during the previous weeks. Each athlete competed for a banner which was awarded to the room having the largest number of points in that grade. The results showed that the second grade banner was a tie between Miss Eva Jones' and Miss Apollonia Petrie's rooms, both of Logan school. The third grade banner went to Miss Marcella Schriner's room, also of Logan school. Miss Lois Sawtelle's fourth grade room of Central school won the pennant for that grade and Mrs. Shirley Meyer's room of Howard school won the fifth grade pennant. The sixth, seventh, and eighth grade pennants went to 6B Howard, 7C Howard and 2B Stolp, tied for seventh grade, and 8A Howard. In the cases of the rooms tied for pennants each room will have the pennant for one-half year.
