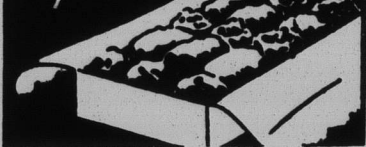

A son was born last Sunday to Mr. and Mrs. A. D. Albright, 1639 Elmwood avenue.

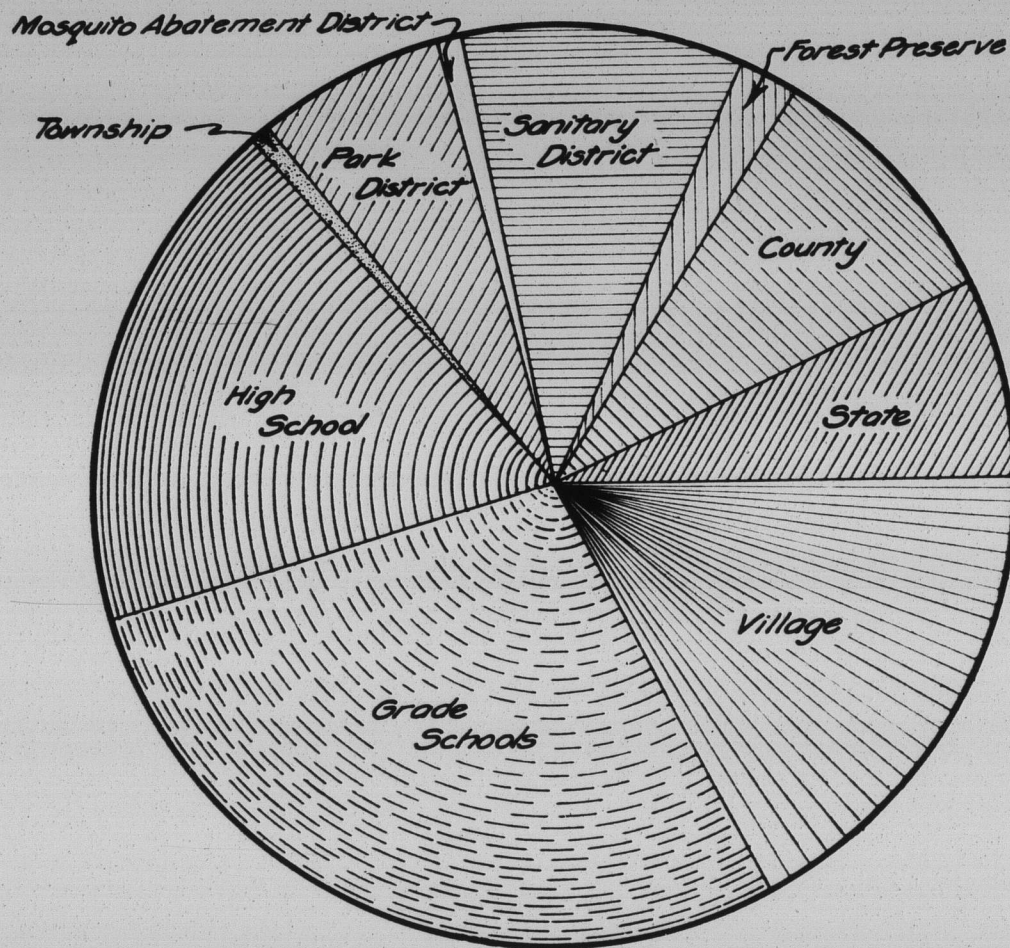

STORAGE**How Your Tax Dollar Is Divided**

The above diagram shows how each dollar paid in taxes by Wilmette citizens for the year 1931 is distributed. These taxes are being collected now.

More than one-fourth of the taxes, 28.2 percent, go to the Wilmette Public schools. The second largest percentage, 18.5, is for New Trier High school. The Village gets 17.6 percent of the tax money.

The remainder of the tax dollar is distributed as follows: Sanitary district, 9.9 percent; Cook county, 9.1 percent; the State, 6.9 percent; Park district, 6.7 percent; Forest Preserve district, 1.9 percent; mosquito abatement district, 0.7 percent, and New Trier township, 0.5 percent.
