P. S. Company Cuts Dividend on Common Stock

The board of directors of the Pub-
lic Service Company of Northern Illi-
nois, at a meeting held last Thursday
declared a quarterly dividend of fifty
cents a share on the company's par
and no par common stock, payable
August 1, to stockholders of record
July 15. This is a reduction of
twenty-five cents per share below the
quarterly dividends paid on the com-
pany's common stock since August
1 of last year. Prior to that time the
dividend was \$2 per quarter. The
directors declared the regular quar-
terly dividends on the 6 per cent and
7 per cent preferred stocks, payable
on the same date as the dividend on
the common stock.

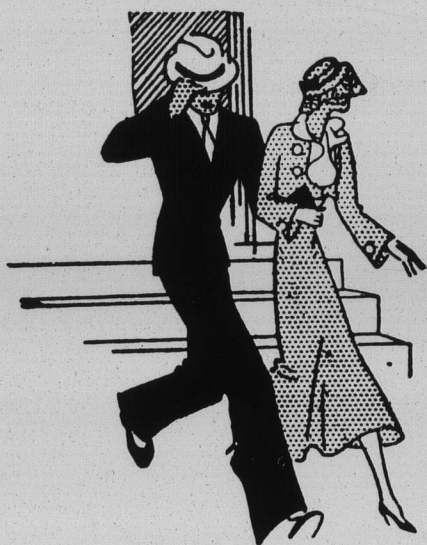
The reduction in dividends on the
common stock was necessitated by
the reduction in rates which will be-
come effective July 1. These reduc-
tions were tendered in response to
pressure of the Illinois Commerce
commission, and will reduce revenues
from electric and gas business in ex-
cess of \$1,000,000 a year. The reduc-
tion affecting the electric rates in-
cludes the new three per cent Fed-
eral tax on residential and com-
mercial business transferred by re-
cent act of Congress from the con-
sumer to the producer.

The company has already made
drastic economies in operating ex-
penses to offset the large loss of
revenue due to the general business
situation. The directors decided that
in order to cooperate with President
Roosevelt in his present recovery
program, no reductions in wages
should be made.

Present estimates indicate that the
gross business of the company for
1933 will be about 5 per cent less
than for the preceding year. The de-
crease in revenue, the increases in
taxation and the reductions in rates
for both gas and electricity make
necessary, in the judgment of the
board, the reduction in the rate of
dividend in order to maintain the
company on a sound basis.
