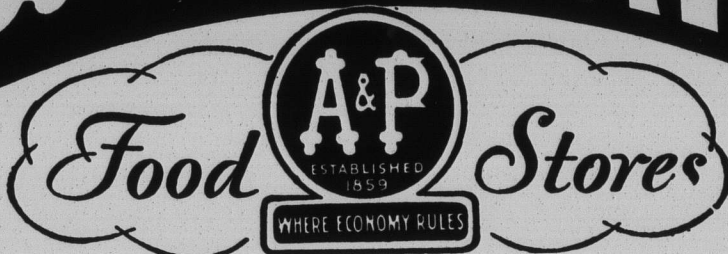
GIVE TEA SUNDAY

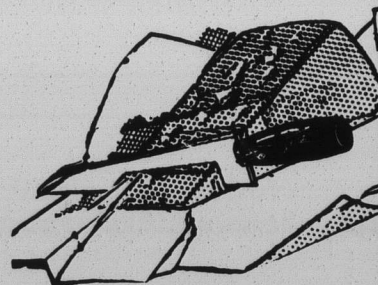
