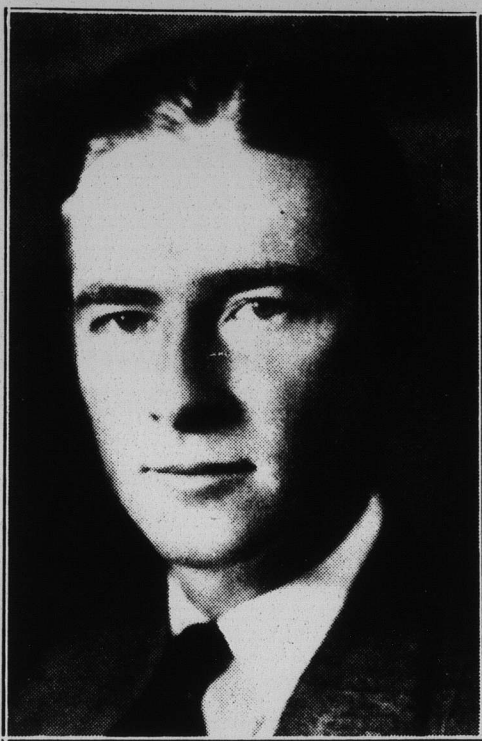


## North Shore Men Operate Orrington

## Select Debaters for N. T. Contests

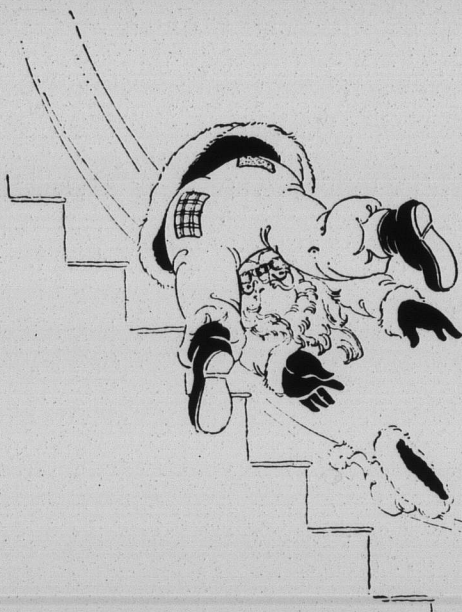
Chester E. MacLean, debate coach at New Trier High school, has announced the selection of the following teams to represent the school in interscholastic competition this year:

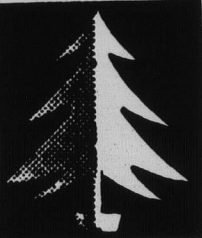
Glenn Walker; third affirmative team—Gerard Brooks, Richard Babcock and Glenn Walker.

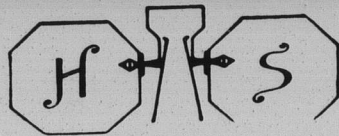
