

## Waukegan Is First Opponent on 1934 Debating Schedule

New Trier will open its 1934 debating schedule in two weeks, meeting Waukegan High school in a dual debate on Friday, February 23. One of the New Trier teams will travel to Waukegan and the other will debate at home.

The three other debates now scheduled also are to be held on Fridays. J. Sterling Morton High school of Cicero will furnish the opposition on March 2, North Park college of Chicago on March 9 and Schurz High school of Chicago on March 23. Only one New Trier team will compete in each of these three debates.

The subject being discussed this year is the question of whether or not the United States should adopt a system of radio broadcasting control similar to that used by Great Britain.
