clothing be checked. This service, it is said, corresponds to that rendered by Evanston at its \$1.00 beach, and affords an inexpensive season ticket for those who do not desire to pay the higher price.

After information as to the cost of beach operation had been presented, it is said, the conferees recognized that the \$2 season family fee would not cover the cost of the same high quality of service heretofore provided at the Lake avenue beach. As one member of the conference put it, "You can't get the best of anything at the lowest price."

### Park Board Control

It is understood that the Village board will delegate to the Park board control of the beach at its two lots on which the new water works stand, in order that there may be no conflict of authority or administration. This will give the Park board control of the entire stretch of beach from the canal to a point 75 feet north of Forest avenue, except three privately owned pieces south of Lake avenue, previously mentioned. Control of these may also be secured through agreement, it is stated.

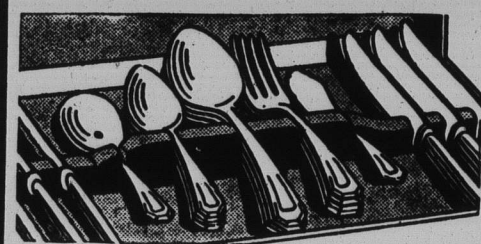
