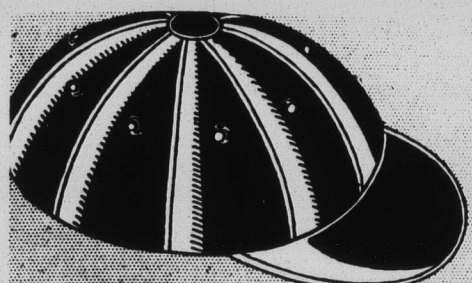


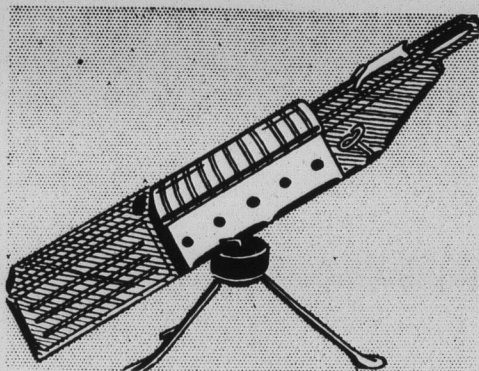

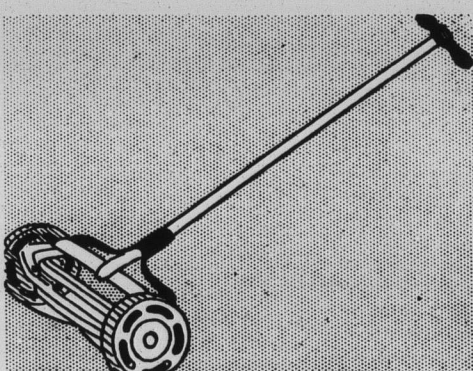
"Pitch That Ball"

"I didn't raise my boy to be a soldier"

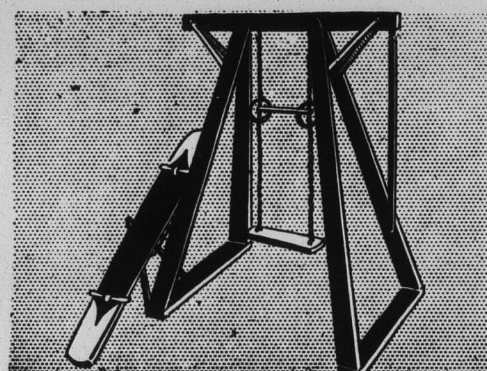
... nevertheless there's a pack of fun in one of these Playboy machine guns, gaily painted and moderately priced at 98c



"Green things growing"

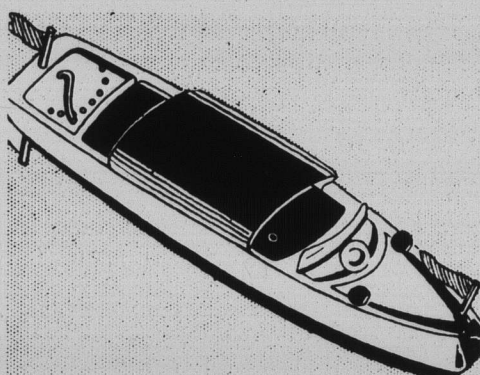
... don't grow so long when one of these toy lawn mowers begins to do its stuff. This one is but 25c

"When I grow up I wanna be a 'nacrobat'!"

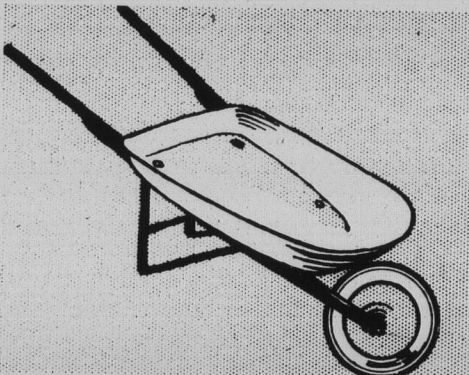

... in the daytime! They are of celluloid and mechanically run and assure hours of fun! Priced at only 59c

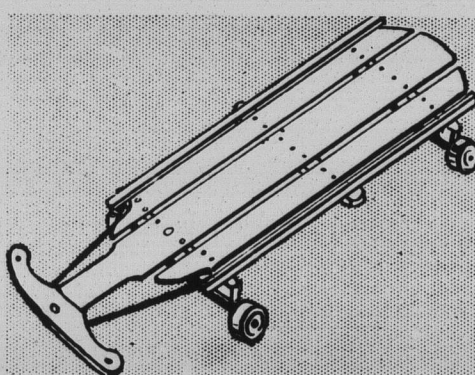

"Jest totin' 'round!"

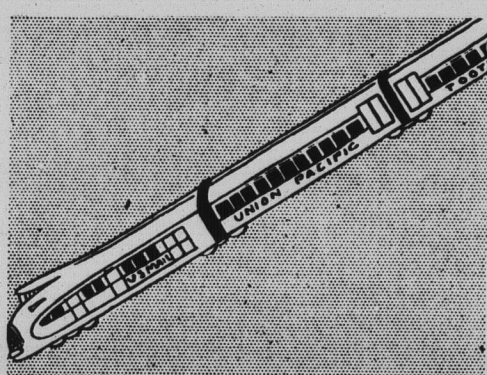
Carrying things in a wheelbarrow is ever so much more sport than just *carrying* them. This sturdy little model is \$1.19

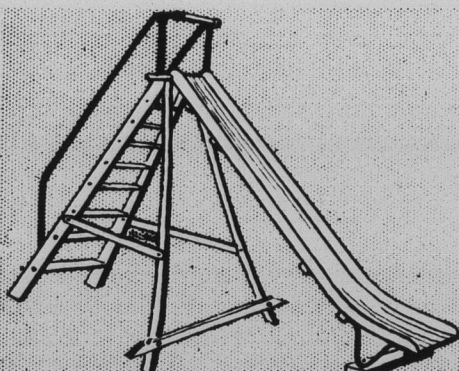
"We were rolling along"

... on what looks like a sled but is in reality a scuttling coaster with ball bearings and a guiding stick. More fun than anything, and just \$1.98



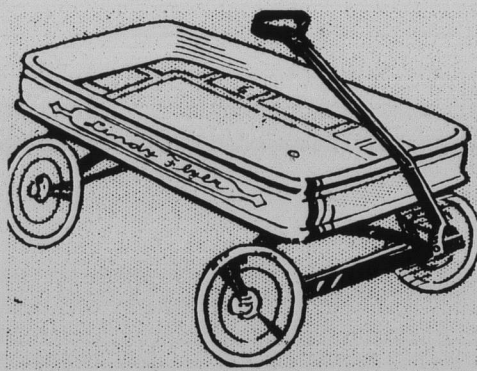
"We're going streamline"

in a Tootsie toy train set patterned after the one the youngsters will see when they visit A Century of Progress. What a thrill they will have! Set 25c



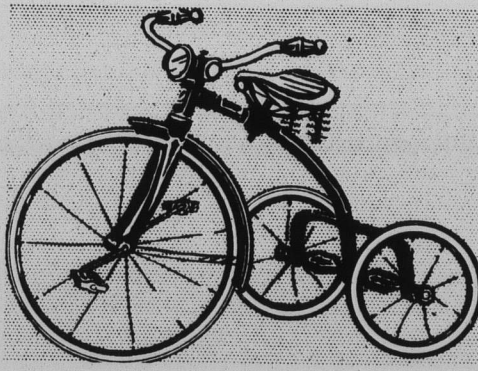
"Up in the air ... and down!"
