

## Johansen Assistant Adjutant of Biggest CCC Dist. in Nation

Ralph Stevenson Johansen, son of Mr. and Mrs. Peter I. Johansen, Bertling lane, Winnetka, is now district assistant adjutant of Sparta, Wis., CCC district, the largest in the United States, it was announced this week. The Sparta district comprises 85 camps and has a total of approximately 17,000 men, including enrollees, their officers, technical superintendents and educational advisers.

Johansen, who received his reserve officer commission at the University of Illinois, Class of '31, now holds the rank of first lieutenant, attached to the 311th engineer reserves.

During the past 19 months he has had many interesting experiences in the north woods of Wisconsin. In May, 1933, he became attached as junior officer of Camp Mercer near Manitowish, serving there continuously until his relief and assignment to headquarters at Sparta, December 5.

While still junior officer at Camp Mercer and in addition to his regular duties, he served for some months last spring as adjutant to the regular army officer, the sub-district commander.

Lieutenant Johansen was made commanding officer of his camp in May.

December 5 he was relieved of that command and transferred to headquarters, Sparta CCC district, where he is now district assistant adjutant.
