Sealed Proposals for the improvement of the thoroughfares described herein will be received in the Council Room of the Village Hall by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Wilmette, Cook County, Illinois, until 8:00 o'clock p. m. June 2, 1936, and at that time publicly opened and read.

The proposed improvements are as follows: (1) Ridge Road between Birchwood and Forest Avenues, known as Extension to State Aid Route No. 047 Section No. 5 C. S., consisting of Portland Cement concrete widening to forty-two feet, face to face of curbs; (2) Wilmette Avenue between Lake and Elmwood Avenues and Tenth Street between Elmwood Avenue and the North Village Limits, known as Arterial Street No. 1 Section No. 1 C. S., consisting of bituminous surface treatment of existing brick pavement.

Plans, specifications and proposal forms for the construction of Section No. 5 C. S. may be obtained from the

Village Manager upon deposit of five dollars, the amount to be refunded upon return of both plans and specifications in good condition within thirty days from the date of receiving Bids. Specifications and proposal forms for Section 1 C. S. may be obtained from the Village Manager without deposit. All Proposals must be accompanied by a bank cashier's check or bank draft for ten per cent of the amount of the Bid, as provided in the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction prepared by the Department of Public Works and Buildings of the State of Illinois adopted by said department January 2, 1932, and Supplemental Specifications effective May 1, 1936.

Cement for this work will not be furnished by the municipality. The President and Board of Trustees reserve the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive technicalities.
