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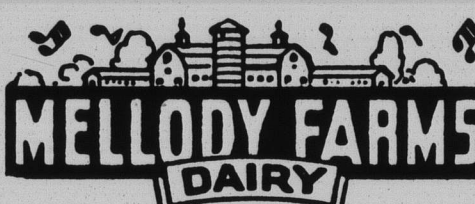
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More Than 63 Per Cent of New Trier 1936 Class Are Attending Colleges

Registrars Survey Shows That N. U. Gets Biggest Group

Over 63 per cent of the members of last June's graduating class at New Trier High school—316 out of 496—are attending college this semester, it was revealed this week when Registrar Harry H. Herron published the list of the graduates and their present colleges.

To Northwestern university went the largest delegation, 39 students in all, with the University of Illinois in second place with 28. Other schools which received ten or more included Carleton college, the University of Chicago, Dartmouth college, and Purdue university. In all, 109 universities, colleges, and advanced preparatory schools are represented on the list.
