

"Awakening of Iran" Lecture at Museum

A free illustrated lecture, "Awakening of Iran," will be presented for the general public Saturday, October 31, at Field Museum of Natural History. Prof. Herrick B. Young, of New York, the lecturer, is a well-known authority on Persian history, and upon the modernization developments that have taken place in Iran in recent years. He has lived in that country for years, serving as professor of English literature at Alborz College in Teheran. He formerly was a correspondent in Iran for the Associated Press. The lecture will begin at 3 o'clock, and will be given in the James Simpson theater of the museum. No tickets are required. Because of the heavy demand for seats, it is necessary to restrict admission to adults; for children, free moving pictures are presented at the museum on Saturday mornings. While a portion of the seats for the lecture is reserved for members of the museum, the greater part will be available to the general public.

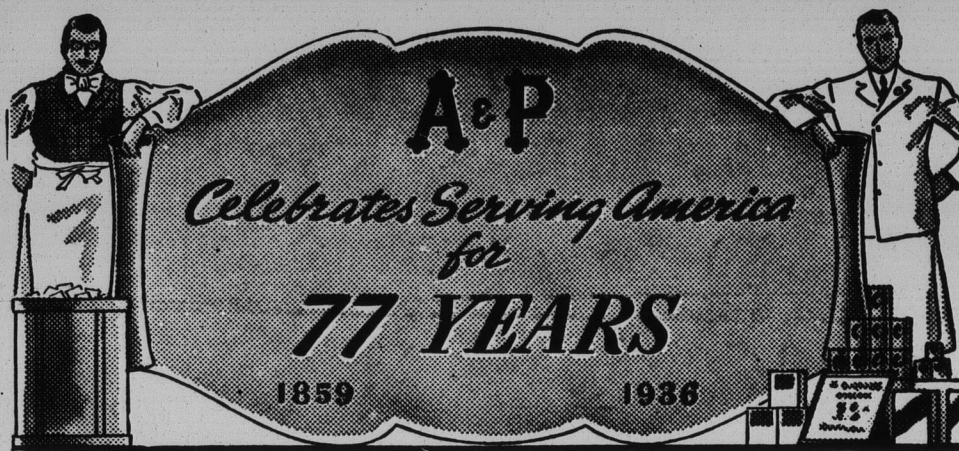
