

## Golfers Awaiting \$10,000 Open at the Medinah Club

Officials of the Chicago District Golf association expect to bring the holders of the major golfing titles of the world together for a showdown in Chicago's \$10,000 Open championship to be played at the Medinah Country club, July 23-24-25. The event is being held to give the midwest a major golfing event and establish a caddy welfare fund.

Horton Smith, who is in England as a member of the American Ryder Cup team, is acting as agent for the Chicago sponsors and has authority to go any distance within reason to sign up the winner of the British Open championship for Chicago. With Ralph Guldahl, national open champion, and Denny Shute, P. G. A. champion, sure starters, the Chicago tournament will only need the British champion to complete the list.

The Chicago tournament has amateur golfers of America stirred up because of the present diplomatic discussions going on between the conservatives of the United States Golf association and the liberals of the C. D. G. A. as to a value limit which should be placed on amateur prizes. Fifteen amateurs have entered from one club in Gary.

Location to erect grandstand seats have been selected and plans developed to conduct putting and driving contests for spectators. The Medinah club grounds are adapted for such purposes and the C. D. G. A. committee wants to give the gallery members an opportunity to try their own skill as well as to observe the methods of the best players.

The C. D. G. A. entered a float in the Chicago Jubilee parade on June 7. It was a miniature golfing hole with tee, fairway and green and a grandstand. This exhibit will be routed through nearby cities a few days before the championship.

## Christian Science Church

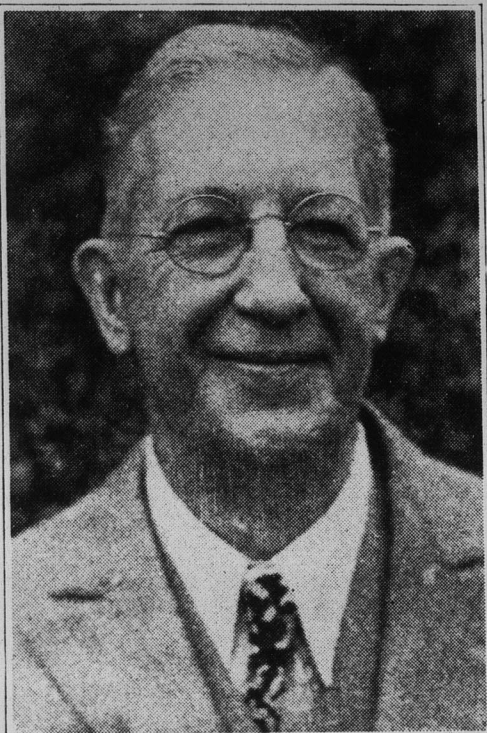
"CHRISTIAN SCIENCE" was the subject of the Lesson-Sermon in all Churches of Christ, Scientist, on Sunday, June 27.

The Golden Text was, "The earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea" (Isaiah 11:9).

Among the citations which comprised the Lesson-Sermon was the following from the Bible: "My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass: Because I will publish the name of the Lord: ascribe ye greatness unto our God. He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he" (Deuteronomy 32:2-4).

The Lesson-Sermon also included the following passages from the Christian Science textbook, "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures," by Mary Baker Eddy: "All Science is divine. Human thought never projected the least portion of true being. . . . No human pen nor tongue taught me the Science contained in this book, Science and Health; and neither tongue nor pen can overthrow it. This book may be distorted by shallow criticism or by careless or malicious students, and its ideas may be temporarily abused and misrepresented; but the Science and truth therein will forever remain to be discerned and demonstrated" (p. 126) 110.

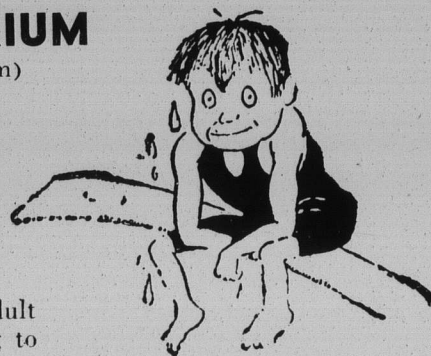
