#### Bridge Lecture

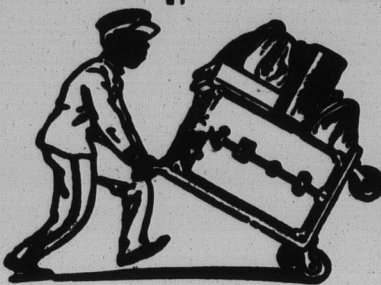
