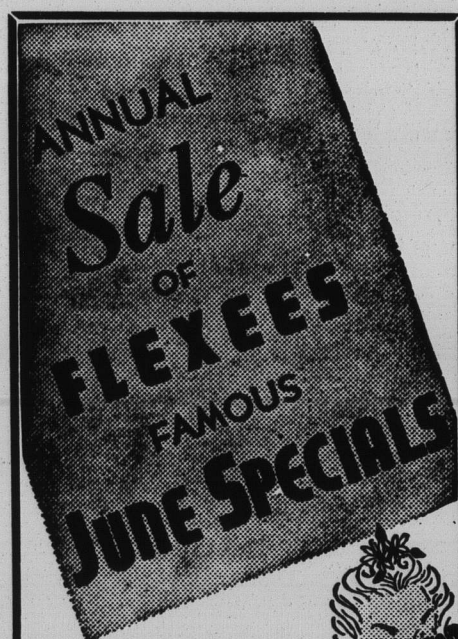
After a wedding trip to the Smoky mountains, Mr. Page and his bride will live in Evanston. They plan to be at home after July 15.
