Two sleeper plane flights are operated daily between Chicago and Pendleton. Passengers leaving Municipal Airport at 10:40 p. m. and 4:15 a. m. reach Pendleton at 8:10 a. m. and 3:28 p. m. In addition to visiting Pendleton, air travelers can enjoy the scenic wonders of the Northwest.
