The King and Queen of Cineland, Clark Gable and Myrna Loy, have established an all-time record for length of an uninterrupted working day for film stars.

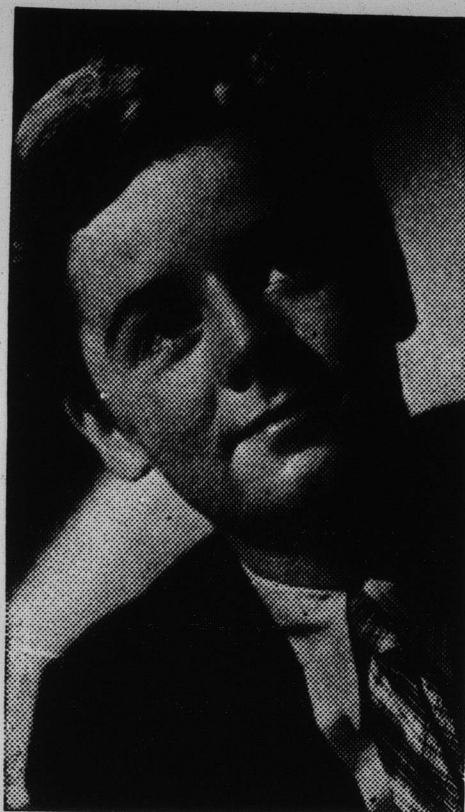

Gable, Miss Loy, Pidgeon, Carrillo and the entire company had worked a total of sixteen and one-half hours.
