**Airline Augments Service to Coast**

Airlines this winter are making a strong bid for vacation travel following the rapid expansion of service during recent months to increase the number of vacation spots now served by air.

United Air Lines, operating the mid-continent airway, offers an easterner the opportunity to fly overnight to the sun-drenched country of California, according to R. F. Ahrens, district traffic manager, who lives in Highland Park. Direct service is offered to nine California cities, including San Diego, Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and Del Monte which is a new stop; Fresno, gateway to Yosemite National park; San Francisco, Oakland, and Sacramento, in the heart of California's grape valley. There is also a side trip flight to Palm Springs, as well as stop-over at Boulder Dam, gateway to a great recreational area.

To make California travel more attractive, United is offering the choice of four routings and inclusion of nine California cities at no extra charge, if desired. To care for the fall and winter exodus to California, United is operating three sleeper planes nightly from the east to the Pacific Coast in addition to scenic daylight flights. Optional routings and circle fares are offered this year.

**Include Sun Valley**

Sun Valley is also included in United's list of attractions as a combination plane service to Cheyenne, Wyoming and Union Pacific Railroad to Sun Valley, bringing this famous and popular Idaho resort within overnight distance of Atlantic seaboard cities, Great Lakes and Midwest points. This year United in conjunction with the Union Pacific is offering all-expense tours to both Sun Valley Lodge and Challengier Inn.

**Indoor Ski-Jumps to Feature Sports Show in Chicago**

With the Izaak Walton league, federal and state conservation departments and associations interested in the preservation of American forests, the prevention of soil erosion and the protection of wild animal, bird, fish and plant life sponsoring exhibits and working for its success, the International Outdoor Sportsmen's show will be held January 21 to 29, in the International Amphitheater in Chicago.

Among the outstanding features of this major exposition will be the introduction in the Chicago district for the first time of indoor ski-jumping. Anders Haugan, world champion ski-jumper, and his associates will give exhibitions twice daily on a ski scaffold which will tower 85 feet from the floor and extend 250 feet into the main arena of the huge exposition building.

Other features announced for the central arena, where seats will be available for more than 10,000 are retrieving dog trials, bait and fly casting tournaments, pistol and rifle shooting contests, table tennis, badminton, wood chopping, log-sawing, horse shoe pitching competitions and a series of spectacular water sports including log-rolling and canoe-tilting. A tank 70 feet long, 30 feet wide and four feet deep will be sunk for the retriever trials and water events.

"Plans for the International were drawn to meet a demand on the part of outdoor enthusiasts—hunters, fishermen and the lovers of life in the open—for a show that will dramatize and feature sports activities, games and pastimes that appeal to a great cross-section of American sportsmen and women," said a show executive.
