The figures, representing the amounts levied by local taxing bodies, which include villages, park districts and school districts, are as follows:

The taxing bodies over which the local taxpayer has no control include Cook county, the Forest Preserve district, the Sanitary district and the Mosquito Abatement district. The figures on these levies are as follows:

Show Education Cost

The cost of education is of vital interest to the taxpayer, even though he may have no children in the schools. For this reason a separate tabulation is presented, in which the tax extensions of the various school districts are broken down to the divisions of educational and buildings, together with budgets, number of pupils and cost per pupil. In any consideration of these it must be understood that the cost per pupil of school operation is based upon the budget, as that is most accurate. The levy may be higher or lower than the actual amount spent, but the budget usually comes pretty close. The number of pupils enrolled is as given by the various school offices this week.

School Budget Increase
