

Health Center Sets Baby Day For Wednesday

Infants to Be Guests at Anniversary Event; Villagers Are Invited

Wilmette Health Center, 905 Ridge road, Wilmette, will observe its second annual Baby Day Wednesday, May 10, at 1:30 p.m. A cordial invitation has been extended to the public to attend.

Invitations have been sent out to 125 babies who have been registered in the Infant Welfare clinics during the past five years. This group includes babies from two weeks to five years of age.

Climaxes Health Program

The Wilmette Health Center, affiliated with the Tuberculosis Institute of Chicago and Cook County, is combining its "early diagnosis" campaign program with Baby Day, along lines laid down by the institute in its campaign against tuberculosis. This will climax the health education program which has been carried on all year by the Health Center staff.

Dr. Noel G. Shaw, pediatrician in charge of the Infant Welfare clinic at the Health Center, will be present to greet the mothers and babies, and Dr. Earl Christie, consultant dentist for the Health Center, will have charge of the pre-school dental examinations.

Registrations will also be taken for the annual immunization clinics which will be conducted at the Health Center later in the month.

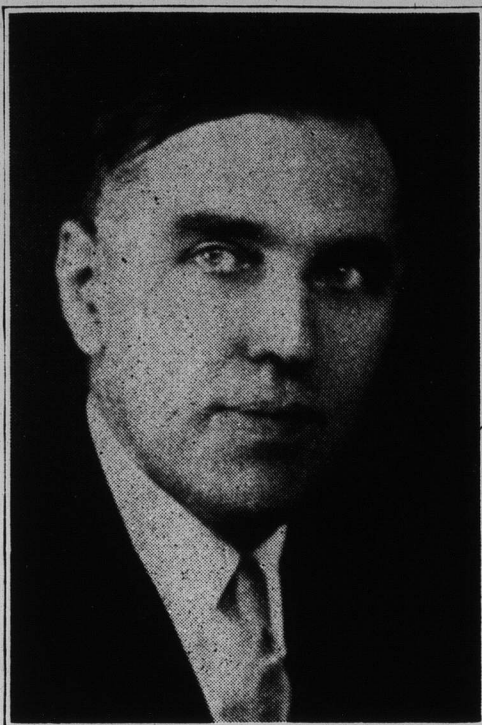
Mrs. Harrison Storms is chairman of the Baby Day celebration and will be assisted by members of the Wilmette Health Center board.
