

With twelve Star sloops in the race, the competition was the keenest that the women skippers have yet had to contend with. Further evidence of this fact is that trailing the winner by 2 minutes the next five boats finished within 1 minute and 15 seconds. Second

place was won by Mrs. Tom Waage in "Pegasus," and third place fell to Mrs. S. C. Pirie, Jr., sailing "Gemini." The course was 9 miles sailed in a brisk southeast wind and consisted of a beat to the 3-mile buoy, a run back to the home buoy, a beat to the twin buoys off Grosse Point light and a run home. The women skippers are showing increased expertness in handling the boats, and, although the men became back

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
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
