Leslev Frost to Found **Book House at Rockford**

Lesley Frost, the daughter of the poet, Robert Frost, has been appointed to the English department of the Rockford college faculty, and will have as one of her first duties the founding of a college Book House and literary center on the campus. The new Book House will be known as "Maddox House," in honor of the former president, Dr. William A.

Maddox, and will be in his old home. Miss Frost, who is almost as well known in literary circles throughout the nation as her famous father, is eminently qualified to act as an adviser for the projected house. Her own book store, The Open Book, in Pittsfield, Mass., has become famous for its lectures and readings, in which such distinguished writers as Walter de la Mare, Robert Frost, Dorothy Canfield, Padrais Colum, Carl Sandburg, and Vachel Lindsay took part

Miss Frost was also the originator of the first Book Caravan which traveled over New England; an invitation to take a book store around the world on the S. S. Franconia followed this successful venture.
