Pi Lambda Phi to Make Medal Award at Annual Session

Dr. Henry Smith Leiper, foreign missions secretary of the Federal Council of Churches of Christ in America, has accepted the chairmanship of a committee of nine leaders in religious, educational and public affairs, who will select the winner of the Pi Lambda Phi Tolerance Award for 1937, it was announced this week.

Serving with Dr. Leiper on the committee are Mayor Fiorella La Guardia of New York; James G. McDonald, former League of Nations high commissioner for German refugees; Prof. Carleton J. N. Hayes, the eminent historian and co-chairman of the National Conference of Jews and Christians; Prof. Joseph P. Chamberlain of Columbia university; Dr. Frank Kingdon, president of the University of Newark; Dr. Jonah B. Wise, rabbi of the Central Synagogue of New York; Joseph C. Hyman, honorary supreme rex of the fraternity; and Herbert R. Kaus, chairman of the national executive council of the fraternity.

The Pi Lambda Phi medal is awarded annually to "that American who during the year convincingly achieved recognition as one who has contributed to the betterment of human relations and the furthering of the democratic ideals upon which our republic was built." Past recipients of the medal include Dr. Leiper, Mayor La Guardia and Mr. McDonald. The medal, this year, is to be awarded at the annual convention of the fraternity to be held at the Palmer House in Chicago on December 30.

Pi Lambda Phi fraternity was established in 1895 as a non-sectarian intercollegiate fraternity, and now has chapters at twenty of the leading universities in the United States and Canada, dedicated to the ideal of fostering good will among all groups on the college campus.

North shore members of the fraternity include Robert J. Koretz and Charles R. Jacobs of Evanston, Eugene Simon of Glencoe, and Joe Lelewer and Arthur N. Oppenheimer of Highland Park.
