High School Students, Teachers to Be Given Test for Tuberculosis

To aid in a general movement to stamp out the growing menace of tuberculosis, particularly among younger people, and especially to detect presence of the disease in its earliest stages, the board of education of New Trier High school, the North Shore branch of the Cook County Medical society, and the health officers of the municipalities in New Trier township, have endorsed a program of tuberculin testing and x-raying of the pupils and teaching staff of the high school, as well as offering to contribute funds and services toward such a program.

A resolution was adopted at the annual town meeting Tuesday afternoon endorsing this program; advising the board of health of New Trier township to co-operate with the other agencies mentioned, and advising the township board to set aside the sum of \$500, any part, or all of which may be used in defraying the cost of materials for x-raying those persons of the teaching staff and student body at the high school, who are recommended by the physicians, for this procedure.

The teachers, it is explained, are taking the examinations this week, and work will be started on the pupils in a few weeks.

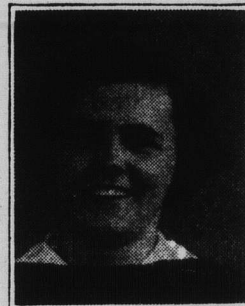
ON HOLIDAY

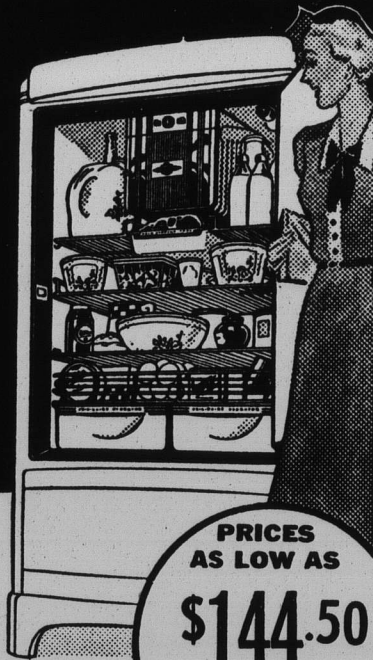
