Concert and dessert series continues at Thunder Bay Theatre

Thunder Bay Theatre's concert and dessert series continues Sunday with a 2 p.m. performance by Three on a String.

Many local residents are already familiar with the threesome of women, who concentrate on playing what is termed "authentic American folk music." Their concerts take the form of old reels, sawyers' songs, hornpipes, fiddle tunes and vintage waltzes that were popular in Michigan in the 1800s. The trio constantly strives to add "new" old melodies to their repertoire.

Three on a String is comprised of Carole Spicer, Carol

Witherbee and Diane Madsen. Spicer, who plays the autoharp, is the 1986 Great Lakes Regional Autoharp Champion. A teacher in the Alpena Public Schools, Witherbee plays the hammered dulcimer and is the 1985 Great Lakes Regional Hammered Dulcimer Champion. The trio's bass player, Madsen, is employed by MichCon.

The cost for Sunday's concert is \$5 for adults and \$4 for students/seniors. Cassettes of Three on a String's music will be available after the performance. The group is also planning to release a second album.
