We have a chance to serve our fellow student more often than we realize. One of the greatest things we can experience as a college student is our lasting relationships which we can establish, with some real effort.

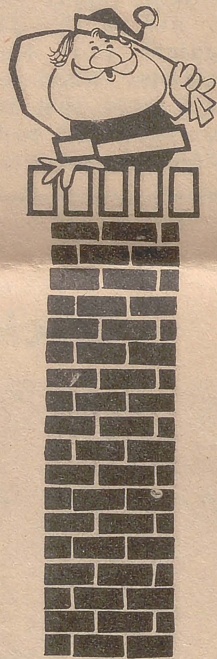
So, in this Christmas season, let's try to get and keep a spirit which will remind us of the constant and lasting fellowship that we all should enjoy here at A.C.C.

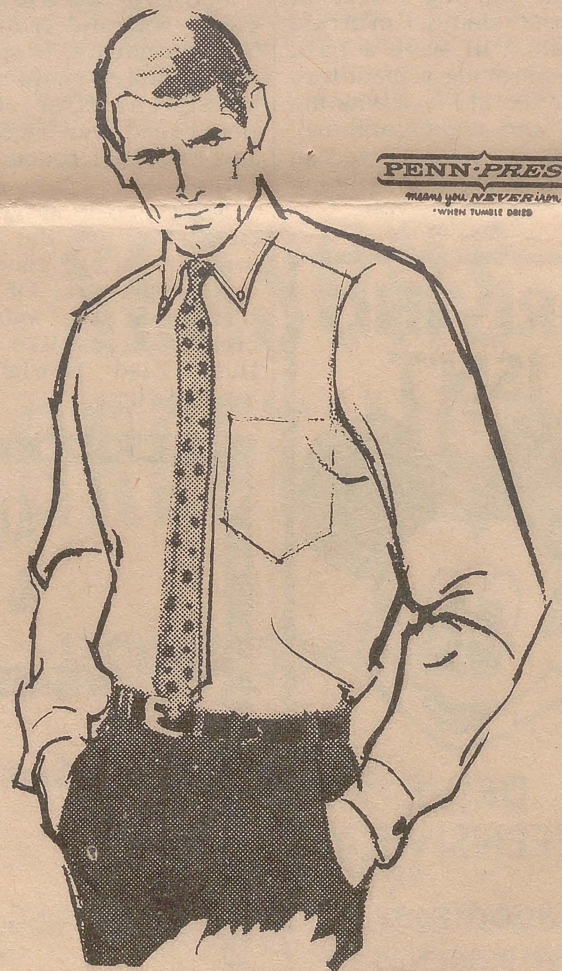
