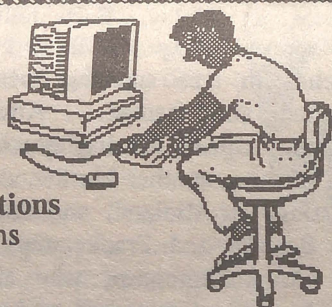
Details will be given at the club meetings, which are held at the times and locations posted in VLH. Be sure to watch the bulletin board for other Ski Club activities.
