
In fact, she has met with hundreds of constituents and assisted more than 500 of them this term with problems they have had with the government.

Serving on Key Legislative Committees.

"Beverly Bodem is Chairperson of the Tourism and Recreation Committee. Beverly also is a member of: Transportation Committee, Public Health Committee and Conservation, Environment and Great Lakes Committees.

Creating Jobs.

 Helped secure state funding for the City of Alpena to study the feasibility of international ferry service between Alpena and Ontario.

Initiating New Legislation.

- Authored 10 new laws this session alone one of the most effective records in the House.
- Helped to pass legislation creation the split in the 33rd Circuit Court, giving Charlevoix its own circuit judge.
- •Introduced a resolution extending the state of emergency in Northern Michigan caused by frozen water mains last winter, resulting in over \$350,000 in state and federal aid to Charlevoix and Cheboygan counties.

Slashed Taxes.

- Voted to eliminate the property-tax based school financing system.
- Voted to place Proposal A on the ballot in order to cap property assessment increases. No more double-digit assessment increases.
- Voted to repeal the Inheritance Tax.
- Voted to cut the Single Business Tax for small employers.
