
Lumberjacks rock Homecoming crowd

A big and enthusiastic Homecoming crowd came to East Campus Saturday, February 3, and saw ACC men and women's basketball teams win a couple of very exciting games.

The women's team came out slow, getting down by 16 early on, but picked up the pace late in the second half and ended up winning (83-80). Key free throws by Sara Roach in the closing seconds helped clinch this big conference win over Schoolcraft.

The Lady Lumberjacks, 2-6 in the conference and 5-12 overall, were led by Bodhi Watts with 19 points. Kristi Whaley added 14 points, nine assists, and pulled down six rebounds. Freshmen sensation Marisa Stoppa had 13 points and 12 rebounds, including the shot to give the Lady Lumberjacks the lead for good. Playmaker Sara Roach chipped in with 10 points as did Crystal Idalski.

The men's game was not as close as the women's, but just as exciting. The men started out slow, falling behind early. They settled down and came out and set the pace, going up by 16 halfway through the first

Near the end of the first half they got a little sloppy and went in at half only leading (48-41).

Schoolcraft cut the lead to six at the start of the second half, then the Lumberjacks caught fire and took total control of the game, pulling away from Schoolcraft (107-92) to improve their record in the conference to (5-5) and (9-10) overall.

Scott Groesser was the spark for the Lumberjacks, scoring a career-high 28 points coming off the bench and taking over the game. Other Lumberjacks in double figures included Nate Tuori with 27 points and 12 rebounds, Mike Gunderson with 12 points and nine assists, and Shaun Craker and Chris Leeseberg with 10 apiece.




