loan.

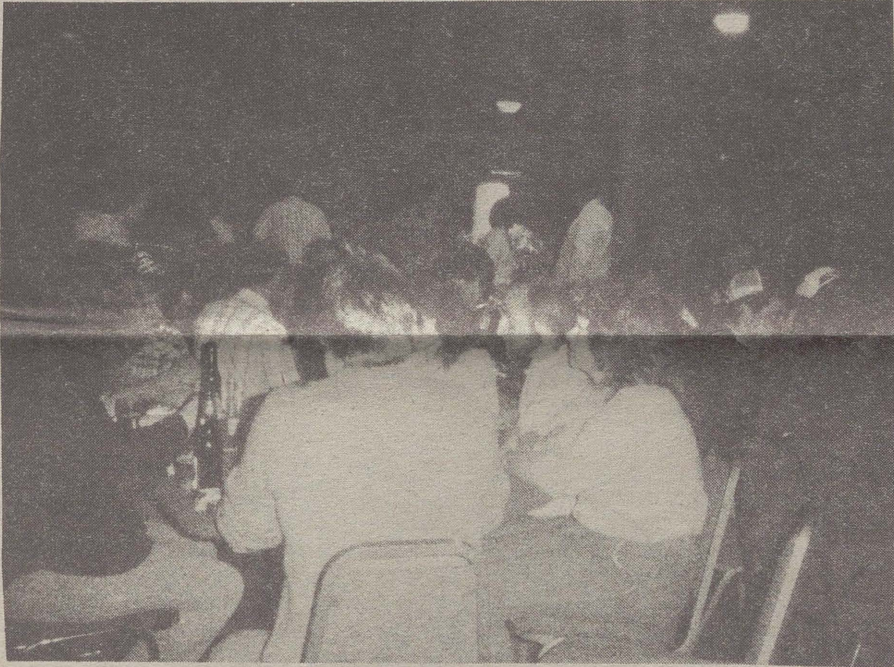
Those who took out a loan to satisfy their craving for more, had to repay it back at the end of the night. The remaining chips the gambler had could be used at the auction.
