who are participating in the intramurals are the same ones time after time.

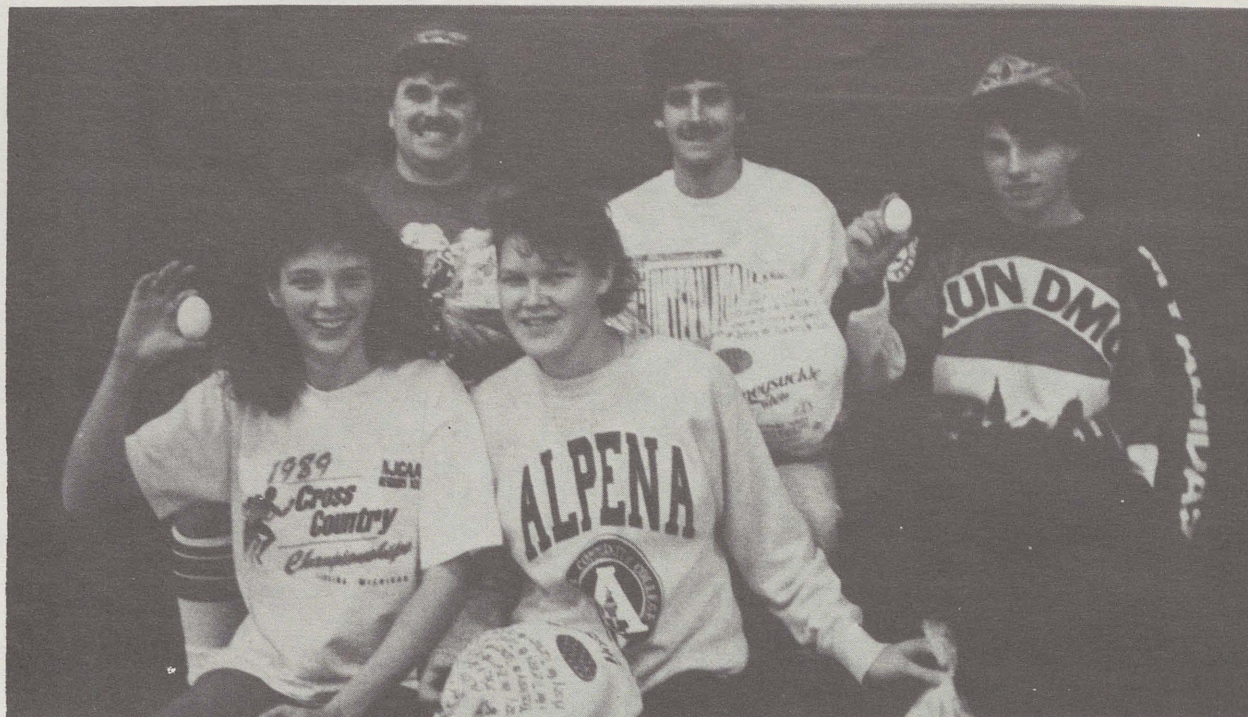
There are a variety of sports offered which range from Volleyball to swimming to bowling and so forth.

How about them Lions? Are we dreaming, or have they actually put together a three-game winning streak? Will the forever-befuddled Lions actually win four straight for the first time since 1980?

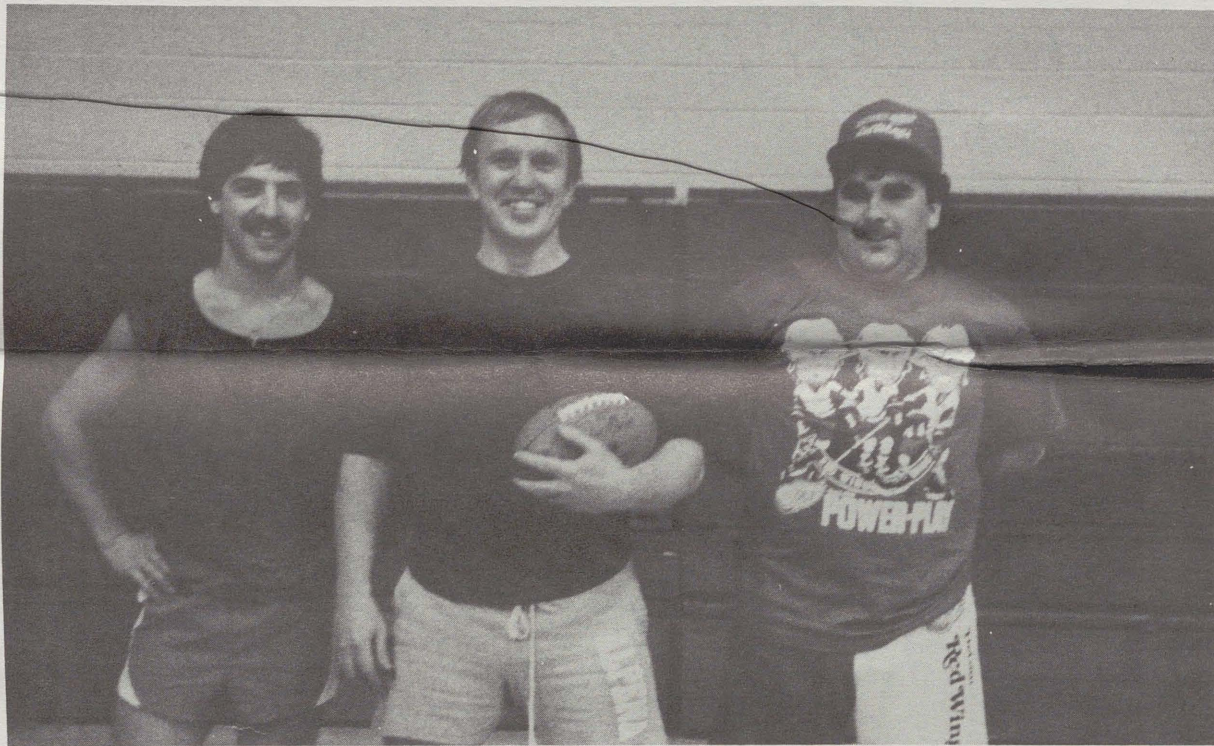

performance of backup quarterback Bob Gagliano complimenting Sanders performance, the Lions are finally beginning to look like a real football team.

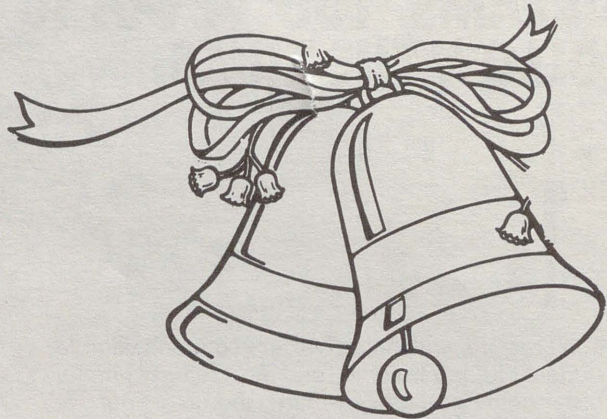
