### Shoreline Players building hosts acting class

For the first time, Alpena Community College will offer Introduction to Acting at the Huron Shores Campus this spring.

A three credit hour class, PFA 231 fulfills a humanities requirement for an associate degree. Offering the class at Huron Shores is in direct response to students' requests, according to Nan Hall, ACC acting instructor.

"Students in the Oscoda area have tried to get involved in the performing arts classes on campus, but often have found

it inconvenient and sometimes impossible because of the distance," Hall said.

Lorraine Reuther, ACC's Foundation Director, will teach the class. She is a former secondary English/Acting/Journalism teacher with 12 years experience directing and producing high school plays.

Reuther pointed out that although this is an acting class, students need not necessarily be solely interested in pursuing a performing arts career to take PFA 231.

"The kinds of skills taught

in this class, in addition to acting techniques and theories, are good communication skills that people need in all walks of life," Reuther explained, "whether in teaching, banking, sales or any career in which one works with people."

"Concentration, observation, voice training, body movement, and thinking skills will all be emphasized."

PFA 231 will be held on Tuesdays from 7 to 10 p.m. beginning Jan. 14. Class will meet in the Shoreline Players Building at 5650 F-41.

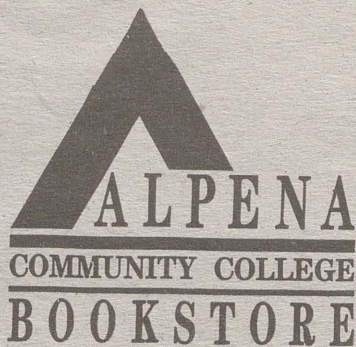
